Classes of use

1. Education or training

- developing assessment or support materials for UK regulated qualifications which are provided at no additional cost to the qualification registration.

To use the IT Professional Standards, you are required to register on-line, and to accept the conditions of this IT Professional Standards Limited End User Licence.

2. Individuals or Organisations

There is no charge for the use of the IT Professional Standards for:

- determining the skills gaps of UK based individuals (including employees) for personal development purposes; or
- determining the skills profiles of UK based employees for organisational development purposes.

To use the IT Professional Standards, you are required to register on-line, and to accept the conditions of this IT Professional Standards Limited End User Licence.

3. Any other use

Any use of the IT Professional Standards which is not covered by 1 or 2 above is subject to a charge. This includes other uses in education and training, by individuals
